DALYELLUP PRIMARY INFORMATION ON VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES FOR 2020

The following information is provided in the hope of making the charges and contributions structure clear for parents. We wish to assure parents that our efforts are directed towards keeping costs as low and as equitable as possible and in accordance with the Education Act Regulations.

The 2020 Charges and Voluntary Contributions sheets provides details on how the voluntary contribution amounts are allocated to learning areas from Kindergarten to Year 6.

Information on maximum costs for other optional activities such as excursions, camps, etc that students may participate in has also been provided.

CONTRIBUTIONS & CHARGES

There are basically three parts to the financial requests.

1. Voluntary Contributions

The School is requesting a voluntary contribution of **\$60 per student from Kindergarten to Year 6** towards the cost of courses in the educational program. These contributions will make a significant contribution to the quality of educational programs that can be delivered.

2. Charges

- (a) **Other optional school-based activities** which address broad learning outcomes and for which there is a high cost – eg excursions, camps, carnivals, etc. A maximum cost for these has been listed, and parents only pay if students take part. These costs will be collected throughout the year as the activities arise.

3. Other Costs.

- (a) **Personal Items** which the students need to own – stationery etc., which can be purchased from any supplier.

ADDITIONAL VOLUNTARY APPROVED REQUESTS

The following voluntary donations also appear on student Contributions and Charges Sheets:

- **P & C Voluntary Donation** - Dalyellup Primary P & C Fundraising Donation for 2020 has been set at \$20 per family. If you would like input into where fundraising monies are spent, please consider becoming a member and attend meetings held twice a term.
- Membership of the P & C Association is \$1 per person and payable at the Annual General Meeting in 2020.

Payment Options

All students will be issued with a statement in Term 1 of 2020 outlining voluntary contributions and charges. Families will have the option in 2020 to pay Voluntary Contributions as part of the Personal Items List.
