

2024 Voluntary Contributions & Charges - Kindergarten to Year 6

The Dalyellup Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Voluntary Contributions and Charges for 2024. The following information is provided in the hope of making the charges and contributions structure clear for parents. We wish to assure parents that our efforts are directed towards keeping costs as low and as equitable as possible and in accordance with the *School Education Act 1999 (WA)* and *School Education Regulations 2000*.

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS & CHARGES

There are basically three parts to the financial requests.

- **Voluntary Contributions**

The School is requesting a Voluntary Contribution of **\$60.00 per student from Kindergarten to Year 6** towards the cost of all consumables and resources used across all learning areas, as well as the options and electives offered to all students. This equates to approximately \$1.50 per student, for each week of the school year. These contributions will make a significant difference to the quality of educational programs that the school can deliver. All parents and carers are urged to support the school.

- **Charges for Other Optional Cost Components**

A breakdown of estimated maximum cost for your child's participation in excursions, camps, carnival, swimming lessons, etc. for 2024 has been outlined in the sample statement. Parents/carers only pay if students take part. These costs will be collected throughout the year as the activities arise.

- **Voluntary Approved Request**

The following Voluntary Approved Request also appear on student's Voluntary Contributions and Charges Statement:

- **P & C Voluntary Contributions** - Dalyellup Primary School P & C Voluntary Donation for 2024 has been set at **\$20.00 per family**, which helps provide much needed amenities for the school. If you would like input into where fundraising monies are spent, please consider becoming a member and attend meetings held twice a term.
- Membership of the P & C Association is **\$1.00 per person** and payable at the Annual General Meeting in 2024.

PERSONAL REQUIREMENTS LIST

- Stationery items including Student Diaries **will not** be available for purchase at school. The cost for items on this list will vary from year level to year level and includes items such as stationery, etc. which can be purchased from our nominated school supplier, West School Supplies, or any supplier. Some items may need to be replenished throughout the year.
- You can also pay your Voluntary Contributions & P&C Contributions for 2024 through West School Supplies when you order your child's Personal Requirements.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

All students will be issued with a statement in Term 1 of 2024 outlining Voluntary Contributions and Charges.

- Or provide **cash in an envelope** to the school office with your child's name, clearly written with the comment **2024 Voluntary Contributions and P&C Contributions**.
- When ordering your 2024 Personal Requirements via West School Supplies.

Flexible payment options can be arranged with instalments set up throughout the year. Parents/carers are welcome to discuss payment plans with the Manager Corporate Services or Principal.

School Refund Policy

School activities (e.g. excursions/incursions, activities/camps) are undertaken by the school on a self-supporting cost basis. If you have paid for an activity and your child is unable to attend, please notify the school as soon as possible. If the school has incurred a cost/s for an activity on behalf of a student it will not be included in the refund, this usually relates to bus fare.
